



How To Prepare For Your Pharaoh Ant Treatment

CHECKLIST

- ☐ All items must be removed from the upper and lower cupboards, cabinets, drawers and countertops in the kitchen bathroom and other areas of activity.
- ☐ All of the items that have been removed from these areas should be kept in the kitchen or bathroom to prevent the spread of the infestation.
- ☐ The kitchen and bathroom must be thoroughly cleaned to eliminate any food sources that the pharaoh ants could be feeding on.
- ☐ Ensure that you pull out the fridge and stove to clean the sides of the appliances as well as the space behind.
- ☐ Walls must be cleaned to remove grease from cooking.

- ☐ Remove all shelf paper from the interior of your cupboards and cabinets.
- ☐ All food items must be stored in pest proof containers, bags or in the refrigerator. Pest proof containers can be easily found at your local dollar store or grocery store.
- ☐ Kitchen and bathroom garbage and organics must be thrown out daily.
- ☐ Pet food must be contained while we are remediating a pharaoh ant infestation.
 - Open pet food provides a perfect source of food for pharaoh ants, it must be contained or it could prolong the amount of time it takes to fully eliminate a pharaoh ant infestation
